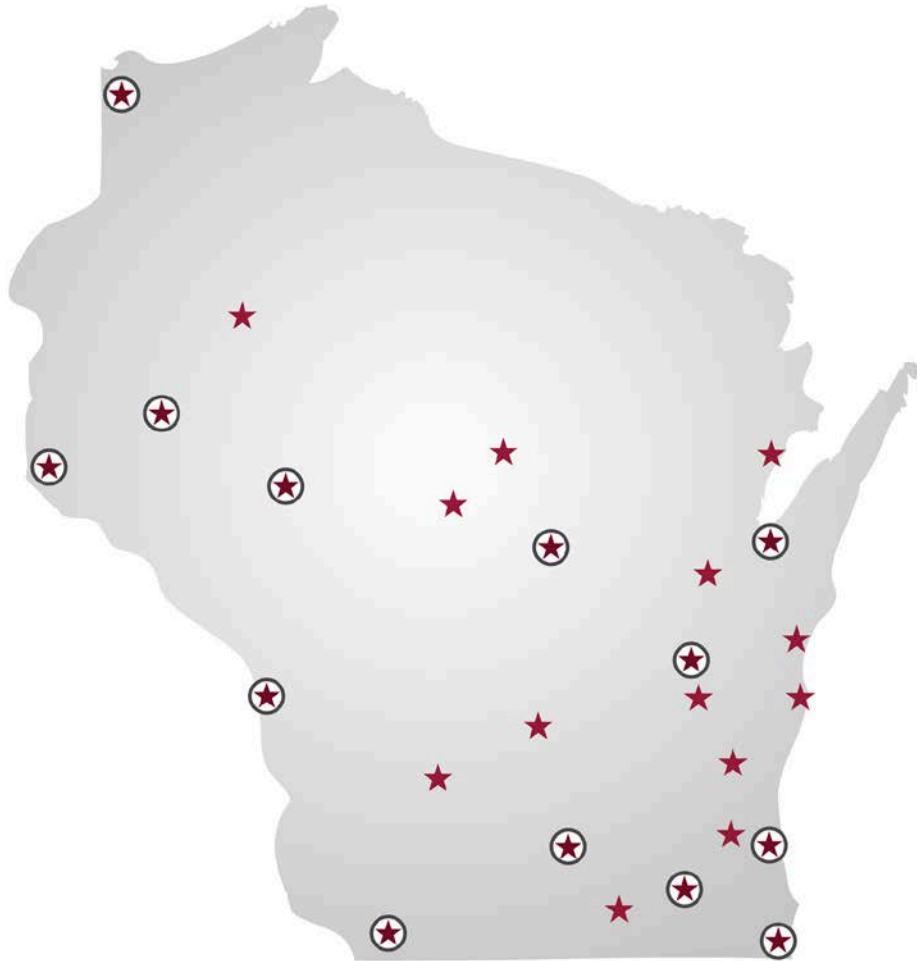

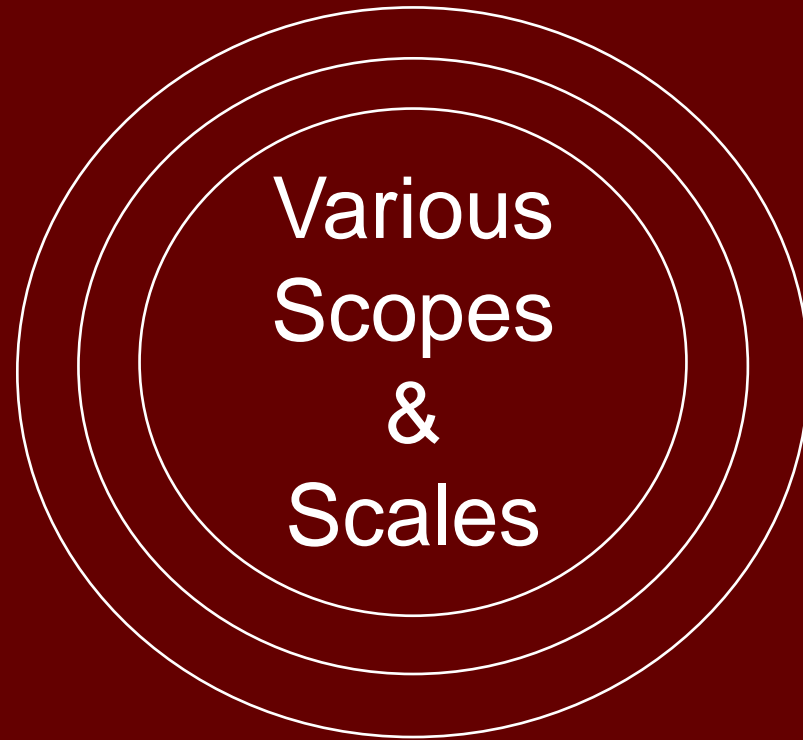

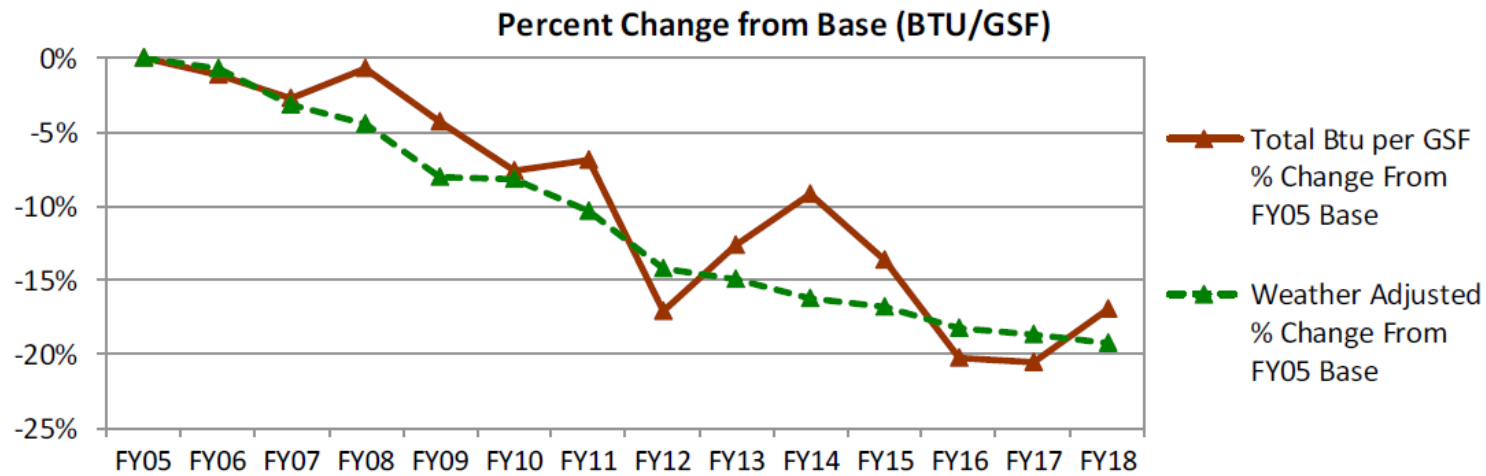

# System & State Utilities



## UW System Uses Over 50% of the State Utility Budget

\$114 Million Utility Expense in FY18 educating ~170,000 students/year

Since 2005...

- 19.2% BTU/Gross Square Foot Reduction- Met Gov. Doyle's Goals
- 13.1% Gross Square Foot Increase
- 6.1% Decrease in Energy Consumption
