Public Records Reminders & Obligations

Public Records Are:

- In general, a public record is anything, paper or electronic, that contains information about your work with this Task Force. Examples include emails, video and audio files, word documents, pdfs, excel spreadsheets, instant messages and texts.
- Public records are property of the state, and the law requires you to keep public records and make them available to the public upon request with very limited exceptions.
- The location of the record does not matter. Emails, text messages or files about the Task Force's work on your personal devices are public records. You must keep them and turn them over upon request.
